10	WHEREAS, Dr. Bristow labored diligently to promote the
11	university's image and marketability, as he remained committed to
12	transforming Alcorn into the educational and social epicenter of
13	southwest Mississippi and northeast Louisiana, ensuring that the
14	institution successfully evolved into a "Public Ivy"; and
15	WHEREAS, a visionary leader who challenged those around him,
16	particularly students, to accomplish as much as possible with an
17	assurance to benefit others with their success, Dr. Bristow
18	appropriately coined the term "ASU equals CEO" for the institution
19	he led with a deep-rooted passion; and
20	WHEREAS, having earned his bachelor of arts, Ph.D and juris
21	doctorate degrees from Northwestern University and his master of
22	arts degree in business administration from Governors State
23	University, Dr. Bristow was well equipped to lead Alcorn into the
