5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of Sections
7	23-15-833, 23-15-835 and 23-15-839 to the contrary, the Board of
8	Supervisors of Tallahatchie County, Mississippi, may call a
9	special election to fill the unexpired term for the board vacancy
10	in Supervisors District 3 on November 7, 2006. The commissioners
11	of election shall give notice of the election by posting notices
12	at the courthouse and in each supervisors district for sixty (60)
13	days prior to the election. Candidates shall qualify by not later
14	than 5:00 p.m. on September 29, 2006. In all other respects, the
15	special election shall be held, conducted and returned in the same
16	manner as provided by general law for filling vacancies in county
17	and county district elective offices.
18	SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
19	shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
20	or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
21	Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
22	District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
23	provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
