16 WHEREAS, the band has won the International Championship 24 17 times during its history; and this year, for the first time ever, 18 won the championship for the 4th straight year in a row, having 19 won in 2003, 2004, 2005, and now 2006. This string of four 20 straight championships is unprecedented by any band from any 21 state; and

22 WHEREAS, the Director/Manager of the band is Mr. Gary Cook 23 from Sumrall, Mississippi, the Assistant Director/Manager is Jeff 24 Cannon from Pearl High School, and the Marching Director of this 25 year's band is Mickey Mangum from Kosciusko High School; and 26 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we express our 27 appreciation to this group of student musicians who have brought
