SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 516

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MISS
2 CAITLYN TERRELL SMITH FOR WINNING THE 2007 MISSISSIPPI JUNIOR MISS

4 WHEREAS, aspiring attorney/broadcast journalist Caitlyn
5 Terrell Smith, Lowndes County Junior Miss, won the coveted 2007
6 Mississippi Junior Miss title during the July 29, 2006, final
7 night of competition at the Temple Theatre in Meridian,
8 Mississippi; and

9 WHEREAS, Caitlyn smiled broadly as she accepted the
10 Mississippi Junior Miss medallion from Virginia Fox, Mississippi's
11 2006 Junior Miss; and

12 WHEREAS, she is the daughter of Representative Jeffrey and
13 Dr. Laura T. Smith of Columbus, Mississippi; and

14 WHEREAS, a shower of confetti fell from the ceiling as the 40
15 other contestants rushed toward Caitlyn, giving her big hugs and
16 kisses, and extending their congratulations; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to the overall state title, Caitlyn
18 received a \$9,000.00 scholarship from the Mississippi Junior Miss
19 Scholarship Foundation and a \$1,000.00 scholarship from
20 Mississippi Coca-Cola Bottlers Association. She also received the
21 overall talent award, a \$1,000.00 scholarship, and she was a
22 double-preliminary winner in scholastics and fitness, \$500.00
23 scholarships for each; and

24 WHEREAS, the program is held under the auspices of the
25 Mississippi Junior Miss, Inc; and

26 WHEREAS, Miss Smith will go on in June 2007 to compete in the
27 America's Junior Miss national finals in Mobile, Alabama; and

28 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize this
29 talented young Mississippi citizen who has brought honor to her
30 parents, her community and her state:
