8	WHEREAS, Ralph is best remembered in the Legislature as an
9	expert in education finance legislation. He served as Budget
10	Director at the State Department of Education from 1985 to 2002,
11	and in this role he acted as a resource to the Education and
12	Appropriations Committees of both houses of the Legislature on
13	such issues as teacher salaries and funding of the revised
14	adequate education formula during critical debates of education
15	funding legislation; and
16	WHEREAS, Ralph held a Bachelor's Degree in Business from
17	Mississippi State University. After his dedicated service with
18	the State Department of Education, Ralph served as the Director of
19	Outreach Services for the Information Systems Division at the
20	Mississippi Department of Transportation until his retirement; and
21	WHEREAS, Ralph was an incredibly strong spirited man, who
22	valiantly fought to remain here with his family throughout his
23	illness. Anyone who ever met Ralph loved him. His strong spirit
24	and goofy good humor lightened even the darkest periods of his

illness. Even to the last, Ralph held strong to his belief and
