

## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 3

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

1           **AMEND** line 1335 by inserting the following after the word  
2 "improvements":

3 that MDA determines to be tourism related

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

1           **AMEND** by inserting after line 1438 the following:

2           (3) If a person, entity or other person submits an  
3 application to the MDA to participate in the incentive program  
4 authorized in Sections 4 through 6 of this act, a gaming license  
5 may not be issued by the state for any establishment located in  
6 the project site.

### AMENDMENT NO. 3

1           **AMEND** line 1324 by inserting the following after the word  
2 "following":

3 that are located in a project as defined in Section 57-75-5(f)(xx)

### AMENDMENT NO. 4

1           **AMEND** by striking Section 8 in its entirety and inserting in  
2 lieu thereof the following:

3           **SECTION 8.** (1) No business, enterprise or other entity that  
4 is, or has ever been, criminally convicted by a court of competent  
5 jurisdiction of intentionally hiring illegal immigrants that  
6 develops or is located in a "project" as defined in Section  
7 57-75-5(f)(xx) and shall be eligible to receive:

8 (a) Any funds provided or derived from the issuance of  
9 any bonds under this act;

10 (b) Any loan, grant or other form of assistance that  
11 may be made available under this act; or

12 (c) Any funds, tax credit or other form of assistance  
13 that may be made available as an incentive payment under this act.

14 (2) If a business, enterprise or other entity that develops  
15 or is located in a "project" as defined in Section 57-75-5(f)(xx)  
16 has received funds or assistance as described in paragraphs (a)  
17 through (c) of subsection (1) of this section, and thereafter is  
18 convicted by a court of competent jurisdiction of intentionally  
19 hiring illegal immigrants, then the business, enterprise or other  
20 entity shall repay the full amount of the funds or assistance  
21 received. The repayment shall be certified by the State  
22 Treasurer, who shall deposit such amounts into the specific  
23 special fund in the State Treasury from which the funds were  
24 awarded, or, in the case of incentive payments under Sections 4  
25 through 6 of this act, into the State General Fund.
