(1) There is created a study committee on the 72 tax system of Mississippi. The committee shall make a report of its findings and recommendations to the Legislature during the 74 2008 Regular Legislative Session, including any recommended legislation. 76 The committee shall be composed of the following (2) 77 members: 78 (a) The President Pro Tempore of the Mississippi 79 80 Senate: The Speaker Pro Tempore of the Mississippi House of (b) 81 Representatives; 82 (c) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations 83 Committee; 84 The Chairman of the House Appropriations Committee; (d) 85 The Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee; 86 The Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee; 87 The State Treasurer, or his designee; 88 (q) The Executive Director of the Department of Finance 89 (h) and Administration; 90 (i) The State Auditor, or his designee; (j) One (1) member designated by the State Tax 92 Commission; 93 (k) One (1) member designated by the State Board of 94 Public Accountancy; 95 (1) One (1) member designated by the President of The 96 Mississippi Bar from the Taxation Section of The Mississippi Bar; 97 (m) One (1) member designated by the Mississippi 98 Supervisors Association; 99 (n) One (1) member designated by the Mississippi 100 Municipal Association; and 101 (o) Three (3) representatives of the general public, 102 one (1) designated by the Governor, one (1) by the Lieutenant 103 Governor and one (1) by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. 105 Appointments shall be made within thirty (30) days after the 106 effective date of this act, and, within fifteen (15) days 107 thereafter on a day to be designated jointly by the Lieutenant 108 Governor and the Speaker of the House, the committee shall meet 109 and organize by selecting from its membership a chairman and a 110 vice chairman. The vice chairman shall also serve as secretary 111.

and shall be responsible for keeping all records of the committee.

A majority of the members of the committee shall constitute a

quorum. In the selection of its officers and the adoption of 114 rules, resolutions and reports, an affirmative vote of a majority 115 of the committee shall be required. All members shall be notified 116 in writing of all meetings, such notices to be mailed at least 117 five (5) days before the date on which a meeting is to be held. 118 (3) The committee shall study and make recommendations with 119 respect to the imposition of state taxes and the granting of tax 120 exemptions in all areas of taxation including, but not limited to, 121 sales taxes, income taxes, privilege taxes, fuel taxes, diversions 122 of taxes and the relationship between state and local taxes. 123 (4) Members of the committee who are not legislators, state 124 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem 125 rate authorized by Section 25-3-69, and shall be reimbursed in 126 accordance with Section 25-3-41 for mileage and actual expenses 127 incurred in the performance of their duties. Legislative members 1.28 of the committee shall be paid from the contingent expense funds 129 of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for 130 committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session; 131 however, no per diem or expense for attending meetings of the 132 committee will be paid while the Legislature is in session. No 133 committee member may incur per diem, travel or other expenses 134 unless previously authorized by vote, at a meeting of the 135 committee, which action shall be recorded in the official minutes 136 of the meeting. Nonlegislative members shall be paid from any 137 funds made available to the committee for that purpose. 138 (5) The committee shall utilize clerical and legal staff 139 already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance 140 made available to it. To effectuate the purpose of this section, 141 any department, division, board, bureau, commission or agency of 142 the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the 143 request of the chairman of the committee, provide to the committee 144 such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the committee 145 properly to carry out its task. 146 * HR03/ R1700*
