7	SECTION 1. Section 49-1-14, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

9	49-1-14. (1) Each person employed by the Commission on
10	Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks as a sworn law enforcement officer
11	who meets the requirements of subsection (2) of this section, and
12	who retires for superannuation or for reason of disability under
13	the Public Employees' Retirement System * * *, upon his request,
14	may be allowed by the commission to retain, as his personal
15	property, one (1) side arm which was issued to him, during his
16	service, provided funds are available for such purpose.

 18 him under subsection (1) of this section, a retiring sworn law
 19 enforcement officer employed by the commission must have attended
 20 and successfully completed the law enforcement curriculum at the
 21 Mississippi Law Enforcement Officers' Training Academy, and must
 22 be certified as a qualified law enforcement officer by the Board
 23 on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Training.
- 24 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 25 and after July 1, 2007.
