HOUSE BILL NO. 65

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-31-51, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT NOTICE MAY BE GIVEN BY PUBLICATION IN A NEWSPAPER
- 3 OF GENERAL CIRCULATION WITHIN THE COUNTY OR COUNTIES OF THE PUBLIC
- 4 IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY PUBLIC UTILITIES FOR CERTIFICATES OF
- PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO ANY PERSON FOR SERVICE IN 5
- UNCERTIFICATED AREAS WITHIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 6
- 7 BOUNDARIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8
- 9 SECTION 1. Section 19-31-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 19-31-51. (1) No public improvement district established 11
- under this chapter shall provide any utility service described in 12
- 13 Section 77-3-3(d) to or for the public for compensation without
- first obtaining a certificate of public convenience and necessity 14
- 15 from the Public Service Commission.
- (2) Nothing contained in this section shall prohibit the 16
- 17 Public Service Commission from issuing a certificate of public
- convenience and necessity to any person for service in 18
- 19 uncertificated areas within public improvement district
- 20 boundaries.
- (3) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, water and/or 21
- 22 sewer districts that petition the Public Service Commission for a
- certificate of public convenience and necessity for any 23
- uncertificated area shall give written notice. Such notice may be 24
- given by publication of a display advertisement that is two (2) 25
- columns wide by five (5) inches deep one (1) time in a newspaper 26
- of general circulation within the county or counties wherein the 2.7
- described district is located or by regular mail to all property 28
- 29 owners located in such area, as reflected on the tax rolls of the

- 30 county or counties at the time of filing the petition, at the
 31 address listed on the tax rolls of the county or counties within
 32 such area, and to public improvement districts and other public
 33 entities located in such area. Such notice shall give the
 34 property owners and the governmental entities instructions on how
 35 they may appear before the Public Service Commission and make any
 36 objections or otherwise participate as an interested party.
- 37 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 38 and after July 1, 2007.
