HOUSE BILL NO. 92

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO REIMBURSE COUNTIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25.00 PER DAY FOR THE COSTS 3 OF HOUSING PERSONS WHO ARE INCARCERATED IN THE COUNTY JAIL BASED 4 ON ACTION TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES AND TO REQUIRE SUCH PERSONS TO REIMBURSE THE DEPARTMENT FOR SUCH COSTS; AND FOR 5 6 RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. Upon vouchers submitted by the board of 9 supervisors of any county housing persons in the county jail who are incarcerated on the basis of action taken by the Department of 10 11 Human Services, the department shall pay to the county, out of any 12 available funds, Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for each person housed in a county jail. The department shall make the 13 14 payment to the county for each day that the person is confined in the county jail beginning with the fifth day following the date 15 16 that the person is incarcerated and terminating on the date that 17 the person is released or otherwise removed from the custody of 18 the county jail. In addition, the department shall pay to the county the actual cost of providing medical care to those persons 19 unless the Executive Director of Human Services finds that the 2.0 costs are unreasonable. The funds received by the county under 21 22 this section shall be placed in the county general fund and shall 23 be expended only for the housing of those persons in the county jail. 24 25 In addition, any person confined in a county jail on the basis of action taken by the Department of Human Services shall 26 27 reimburse the department Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for

confinement in a county jail. The reimbursement that such person

shall make shall be for each day that person is confined in the

- 30 county jail beginning with the fifth day following the date that
- 31 the person is incarcerated and terminating on the date that the

- 34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 35 and after July 1, 2007.
