HOUSE BILL NO. 109

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON UNDER EIGHT YEARS OF AGE TO RIDE WITHIN OR UPON ANY PORTION OR AREA OF A 2 3 MOTOR VEHICLE NOT DESIGNED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS; 4 TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. (1) When a motor vehicle is being operated upon 7
- 8 any public road, street or highway within this state, a person
- 9 under eight (8) years of age may not ride, and any person
- 10 operating a motor vehicle may not knowingly permit any person
- under eight (8) years of age to ride, within or upon any portion 11
- 12 or area of the motor vehicle that is not designed by the vehicle
- manufacturer for the transportation of passengers. 13
- 14 (2) Any person violating the provisions of subsection (1) of
- this section, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor and 15
- shall be punished as provided in Section 63-9-11. 16
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified in 17
- Chapter 3, Title 63, Mississippi Code of 1972. 18
- 19 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- and after July 1, 2007. 20
