## HOUSE BILL NO. 127

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER TO DRIVE OR OTHERWISE OPERATE A
- VEHICLE IN VIOLATION OF THE IMPLIED CONSENT LAW WITH A VEHICLE 3
- 4 OCCUPANT WHO IS UNDER TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE; AND FOR RELATED
- 5 PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) It is unlawful for any person twenty-one
- 8 (21) years of age or older to drive or otherwise operate a vehicle
- in violation of subsection (1) of Section 63-11-30, with a vehicle 9
- occupant who is under twenty-one (21) years of age. 10
- (2) A violation of subsection (1) of this section shall 11
- 12 constitute an offense separate and in addition to an offense under
- Section 63-11-30 or any other offense, violation of which shall 13
- 14 constitute a misdemeanor punishable, upon conviction, by a fine of
- not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), by imprisonment 15
- for not more than one (1) year, or by both such fine and 16
- imprisonment. 17
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18
- 19 and after July 1, 2007.
