## HOUSE BILL NO. 128

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-1-8, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
AUTHORIZE THE MISSISSIPPI BAR TO ENFORCE THE LAW REGARDING
ADVERTISING BY OUT OF STATE ATTORNEYS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 11-1-8, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 11-1-8. The Legislature recognizes that attorneys should be licensed by the State of Mississippi before engaging in any 8 solicitation of clients in this state. Such licensing of 9 attorneys protects the people of Mississippi in that The 10 11 Mississippi Bar has direct jurisdiction over attorneys licensed by it. The Mississippi Supreme Court can act against such licensed 12 attorneys in the event that such licensed attorneys commit 13 violations of Mississippi law, court rules and rules of ethics for 14 15 attorneys. The Legislature finds that this section is necessary for the protection of the people of Mississippi. An attorney who 16 is not admitted to The Mississippi Bar shall not advertise his 17 legal services in this state for the purpose of soliciting 18 prospective clients for commencement of any civil action in this 19 20 state, or for the purpose of soliciting clients for any civil action already commenced or pending in this state, unless the 21 attorney who is not a member of The Mississippi Bar has associated 2.2 an attorney who (a) is a member of The Mississippi Bar; and (b) 23 will be associated and actively working on substantial aspects in 24 any civil action filed on behalf of a client solicited as a result 25 of the advertisement. A law firm composed of both attorneys who 26 27 are members of The Mississippi Bar and attorneys who are not

28 members of The Mississippi Bar may advertise in this state if a 29 majority of the members of the firm are members of The Mississippi 30 Bar. For purposes of this section, a listing in the residential 31 or business section of the white pages of a telephone book shall 32 not be an advertisement. <u>The Mississippi Bar is authorized to</u> 33 <u>enforce the provisions of this section.</u>

34 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 35 and after July 1, 2007.
