HOUSE BILL NO. 151

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 75-85-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE PERSONS EXEMPT FROM THE TRANSIENT VENDOR LAW TO NOTIFY 2 POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS WHEN THEY INTEND TO TRANSACT BUSINESS; AND 3 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 75-85-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 amended as follows: 7 8 75-85-3. (1) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply 9 to: Civic and nonprofit organizations or wholesale 10 (a) 11 sales to retail merchants by commercial travelers; (b) Wholesale trade shows or conventions; 12 Sales of goods, wares, services or merchandise by 13 (C) sample, catalogue or brochure for future delivery; 14 Fairs and convention center activities conducted 15 (d) 16 primarily for amusement or entertainment; 17 (e) Any general sale, fair, circus, auction or bazaar sponsored by a church or religious organization; 18 Garage sales held on premises devoted to 19 (f) residential use; 20 21 (q) Sales or repairs of crafts or sales or repairs of 22 items made by hand by the person making the crafts or items; 23 (h) Duly licensed flea markets operating from a fixed 24 location; 25 (i) Sales of agricultural, dairy, poultry, seafood or 26 forest management products or services related to forest management or silvicultural activities, nursery products, foliage 27

28 plants or ornamental trees, except such products or services sold 29 at retail and not grown or produced within Mississippi;

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(j) Sales of agricultural services.

31 (2) A transient vendor not otherwise exempted from this 32 chapter is not exempted from this chapter because of a temporary 33 association with a local dealer, auctioneer, trader, contractor or 34 merchant, or by conducting the transient business in connection 35 with or in the name of any local dealer, auctioneer, trader, 36 contractor or merchant.

37 (3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) of this
38 section, any person or entity exempt from the provisions of this
39 chapter under subsection (1) of this section who transacts
40 business in a county or municipality in this state shall notify,
41 in writing, the county or municipality where the person or entity
42 intends to transact business.

43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2007.
