## HOUSE BILL NO. 166

- AN ACT TO PROVIDE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE 1 AND RENEWAL OF MOTOR VEHICLE TAG PERMITS FOR USED MOTOR VEHICLE 2
- DEALERS; TO AMEND SECTION 27-19-305, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 3
- 4
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
- 27-19-306, Mississippi Code of 1972: 7
- 27-19-306. (1) Beginning January 1, 2008, every application 8
- 9 for the issuance or renewal by a used motor vehicle dealer of a
- motor vehicle tag permit must be accompanied by, or supported by, 10
- 11 such evidence as the State Tax Commission shall prescribe,
- documenting the completion of an education seminar, approved by 12
- 13 the commission, during the twelve-month period immediately
- preceding the date of application. Completion of an eight-hour 14
- 15 licensing course is required for an initial permit and completion
- 16 of a four-hour continuing education course is required for renewal
- 17 of the permit. The education requirements of this section do not
- apply to a used motor vehicle dealer whose primary business is the 18
- sale of salvage vehicles on behalf of insurers or to a 19
- manufactured home dealer. The education requirements of this 20
- 21 section do not apply to persons who are age sixty-two (62) years
- 22 or older before January 1, 2008, and who are seeking to renew a
- 23 permit.
- 24 The State Tax Commission may grant prior approval to any
- of the following types of educational activities to meet 25
- 26 continuing education requirements:
- 27 Seminars approved by the State Tax Commission;

- 28 (b) National or state automobile association sponsored
- 29 seminars, courses of instruction or meetings;
- 30 (c) Courses related to used motor vehicles at any state
- 31 certified institution of higher learning;
- 32 (d) Seminars or courses related to used cars sponsored
- 33 or participated in by any state or federal agency; and
- 34 (e) Any other seminar, course or meeting that the
- 35 commission deems to be appropriately related to the used car
- 36 business.
- 37 (3) Requests for approval of any continuing educational
- 38 activity must be submitted to the State Tax Commission before the
- 39 date of attendance and must include a complete and specific
- 40 description of the educational activity, a description of how it
- 41 will benefit permittees in conducting their businesses, the number
- 42 of hours involved, a description of the method that will be used
- 43 to ensure attendance and copies of any instructional materials
- 44 that will be provided to attendees. At the time approval is
- 45 granted, the State Tax Commission shall determine how many hours
- 46 of continuing education a permittee may receive by attending the
- 47 program. If the State Tax Commission deems that a previously
- 48 approved educational activity is not meeting the requirements for
- 49 continuing education, it may revoke the approval of the activity.
- 50 (4) The State Tax Commission may deny an application for a
- 51 permit or revoke a permit for failure to comply with the
- 52 provisions of this section.
- 53 **SECTION 2.** Section 27-19-305, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 54 amended as follows:
- 55 27-19-305. A dealer shall make application to the commission
- on forms prescribed and furnished him to obtain a distinguishing
- 57 number for such motor vehicles as are owned by such dealer. The
- 58 commission shall issue to the applicant a motor vehicle dealer tag
- 59 permit containing the name and address of the dealership and such
- 60 further information as the commission may determine to be

- 61 necessary; however, used motor vehicle dealers must meet the
- 62 educational requirements of Section 27-19-306 in order to be
- 63 issued a permit. The place of business or agency herein referred
- 64 to shall mean a place in any city, town, or locality where motor
- 65 vehicles owned or assigned to such dealer are regularly kept or
- 66 exposed for sale in the custody or control of the dealer,
- 67 salesman, employee, or agent of such dealer.
- 68 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 69 and after July 1, 2007.
