- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful for a judge of any court of this
- 6 state to restrict or attempt to restrict the exercise of free
- 7 speech as guaranteed by the United States Constitution. Any judge
- 8 who violates the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a
- 9 misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined an amount not to
- 10 exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

- 12 and after July 1, 2007.
