- **SECTION 1.** (1) When a motor vehicle is being operated upon 7
- 8 any public road, street or highway within this state, a person
- under eighteen (18) years of age may not ride, and any person 9
- operating a motor vehicle may not knowingly permit any person 10
- under eighteen (18) years of age to ride, within or upon any 11
- 12 portion or area of the motor vehicle that is not designed by the
- vehicle manufacturer for the transportation of passengers. 13
- (2) Any person violating the provisions of subsection (1) of 14
- 15 this section, upon conviction, is guilty of a misdemeanor and
- shall be punished as provided in Section 63-9-11. 16
- SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified in 17
- Chapter 3, Title 63, Mississippi Code of 1972. 18
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19
- 20 and after July 1, 2007.
