## HOUSE BILL NO. 406

- AN ACT TO REQUIRE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS TO COMPLETE A
  CERTIFIED DRIVER EDUCATION TRAINING PROGRAM AS A CONDITION FOR
  HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION; TO AMEND SECTION 37-25-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE
  OF 1972, TO REQUIRE ALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN
  DRIVER EDUCATION AND TRAINING PROGRAMS; TO AMEND SECTION 37-25-7,
  MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO PRESCRIBE
  REGULATIONS ESTABLISHING WHEN STUDENTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE
  IN DRIVER EDUCATION AND TRAINING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 10 **SECTION 1.** In addition to all other requirements for
- 11 graduation prescribed by the State Board of Education and local
- 12 school boards, a student must successfully complete a certified
- 13 driver education and training program as a condition for
- 14 graduation from a public high school in Mississippi.
- SECTION 2. Section 37-25-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 16 amended as follows:
- 17 37-25-3. The school board of every school district shall
- 18 establish and maintain driver education and training programs for

pupils enrolled in the \* \* \* secondary schools in that district.

- 20 **SECTION 3.** Section 37-25-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 21 amended as follows:

- 22 37-25-7. Each school district \* \* \* shall prescribe
- 23 regulations establishing when a student is eligible to receive
- 24 instruction in the driver education and training program. The
- 25 regulations must require, at a minimum, that any student receiving
- 26 instruction under this chapter shall be:
- 27 (a) Fourteen years of age or above;
- 28 (b) A regularly enrolled student in the ninth, tenth,
- 29 eleventh or twelfth grade; and

| 32 | Any driver education student under fifteen (15) years of age       |
| 33 | shall secure a learner's permit issued by the Department of Public |
| 34 | Safety which shall be valid only while the student is under the    |

- 37 consists of thirty (30) hours of classroom and six (6) hours of
- 38 dual driving instruction. The learner's permit shall expire at
- 39 the end of the driver training course. The Department of Public
- 40 Safety shall charge a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) for the issuance
- of a learner's permit. 41
