7	SECTION 1. Each physician or psychiatrist licensed in the
8	State of Mississippi who diagnoses any children with Attention
9	Deficit Disorder (ADD) or Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
10	(ADHD) shall report the total number of such diagnoses in children
11	made by the physician or psychiatrist to the respective school
12	districts where the children attend school. The report must be
13	made to the school districts before July 1 of each year for the
14	twelve-month period beginning June 1 of the preceding year and
15	ending the following May 31.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2007.
