7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 63-3-519, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	63-3-519. $\underline{(1)}$ It \underline{is} unlawful for any person or peace
11	officer or law enforcement agency, except the Mississippi Highway
12	Safety Patrol, to purchase or use or allow to be used any type of
13	radar speed detection equipment upon any public street, road or
14	highway of this state. However, such equipment may be used:
15	(a) By municipal law enforcement officers within a
16	municipality having a population of two thousand (2,000) or more
17	upon the public streets of the municipality;
18	(b) By any college or university campus police force
19	within the confines of any campus wherein more than two thousand
20	(2,000) students are enrolled;
21	(c) By municipal law enforcement officers in any
22	municipality having a population in excess of fifteen thousand
23	(15,000) according to the latest federal census on federally
24	designated highways lying within the corporate limits; and
25	(d) By law enforcement officers employed by the
26	Mississippi Department of Transportation to enforce speed limits
27	for commercial motor vehicles having a gross vehicle weight
28	greater than Ten Thousand (10,000) pounds on highways and roads on

the designated state highway system.
