HOUSE BILL NO. 506

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COMPREHENSIVE COURSE IN MISSISSIPPI 2 HISTORY TO BE TAUGHT TO ALL NINTH GRADE STUDENTS IN THE PUBLIC 3 SCHOOLS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 5 SECTION 1. In addition to the curriculum otherwise required by law or the State Board of Education to be taught in the public 6 7 schools of this state, a comprehensive course in Mississippi 8 History is required for all ninth grade students. The objective 9 of the Mississippi History course must be to provide students with an examination of the history of the State of Mississippi from the 10 11 age of discovery and colonization to the present with particular emphasis on the significant political, social, economic and 12 cultural issues of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries which 13 have impacted the diverse ethnic and racial populations of the 14 15 state.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 17 and after July 1, 2007.
