## HOUSE BILL NO. 511

1 AN ACT TO CREATE A TASK FORCE TO STUDY THE TAX SYSTEM OF THIS STATE AND TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS THEREON TO THE LEGISLATURE; AND 2 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. (1) There is created a task force to study the tax system of Mississippi. The task force shall make a report of 6 7 its findings and recommendations to the Legislature during the 8 2007 Regular Legislative Session and each regular legislative session thereafter, including any recommended legislation. 9 (2) The task force shall be composed of the following 10 11 twenty-five (25) members: (a) Ten (10) members appointed by the Speaker of the 12 13 Mississippi House of Representatives as follows: 14 (i) The Speaker Pro Tempore of the House; (ii) The Chairman of the House Ways and Means 15 Committee; 16 (iii) The Chairman of the House Appropriations 17 18 Committee; (iv) Two (2) certified public accountants from a 19 20 list of twenty (20) certified public accountants submitted by the State Board of Public Accountancy; 21 (v) A representative of the Mississippi 2.2 Supervisors Association; 23 (vi) A representative of the Mississippi Municipal 24 25 League; (vii) A representative of one (1) of the state 26 27 institutions of higher learning; and \* HR03/ R1012\* H. 28 (viii) Two (2) representatives of the general 29 public; Ten (10) members appointed by the Lieutenant 30 (b) Governor of the State of Mississippi as follows: 31 32 (i) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate; 33 The Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee; (ii) 34 (iii) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations Committee; 35 (iv) Two (2) certified public accountants from a 36 37 list of twenty (20) certified public accountants submitted by the State Board of Public Accountancy; 38 39 (v) A representative of the Mississippi 40 Manufacturers Association; (vi) A representative of the Taxation Section of 41 The Mississippi Bar; 42 43 (vii) A representative of one (1) of the state 44 institutions of higher learning; and 45 (viii) Two (2) representatives of the general 46 public; and 47 Five (5) members appointed by the Governor of the (C) 48 State of Mississippi as follows: 49 (i) The Chairman of the Mississippi State Tax 50 Commission; 51 (ii) The Executive Director of the Mississippi 52 Development Authority; 53 (iii) A representative of one (1) of the state 54 institutions of higher learning; and 55 (iv) Two (2) representatives of the general 56 public. 57 Appointments shall be made within fifteen (15) days (3) after the effective date of this act, and, within twenty-one (21) 58 59 days thereafter the task force shall submit its initial report of 60 findings and recommendations to the Legislature. 61 the members of the task force shall constitute a quorum. In the 62 selection of its officers and the adoption of rules, resolutions 63 and reports, an affirmative vote of a majority of the task force 64 shall be required.

65 (4) The task force shall study and make recommendations 66 regarding the imposition of state taxes and the granting of tax 67 exemptions in all areas of taxation including, but not limited to, 68 sales taxes, income taxes, privilege taxes, fuel taxes, diversions 69 of taxes and the relationship between state and local taxes.

70 (5) Members of the task force who are not legislators, state 71 officials or state employees shall be compensated at the per diem 72 rate authorized by Section 25-3-69 and shall be reimbursed in 73 accordance with Section 25-3-41 for mileage and actual expenses 74 incurred in the performance of their duties. Legislative members 75 of the task force shall be paid from the contingent expense funds 76 of their respective houses in the same manner as provided for 77 committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session. 78 However, no per diem or expense for attending meetings of the task 79 force will be paid to legislative members of the task force while 80 the Legislature is in session. No task force member may incur per 81 diem, travel or other expenses unless previously authorized by 82 vote, at a meeting of the task force, which action shall be 83 recorded in the official minutes of the meeting. Nonlegislative members shall be paid from any funds made available to the task 84 85 force for that purpose.

The task force shall use clerical and legal staff 86 (6) 87 already employed by the Legislature and any other staff assistance made available to it. To effectuate the purposes of this section, 88 any department, division, board, bureau, commission or agency of 89 90 the state or of any political subdivision thereof shall, at the request of the chairman of the task force, provide to the task 91 92 force such facilities, assistance and data as will enable the task 93 force to properly carry out its tasks.
