HOUSE BILL NO. 519

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT AN ELECTED OFFICIAL FROM CHANGING HIS OR 1 2 HER POLITICAL PARTY AFFILIATION DURING THE OFFICIAL'S TERM OF 3 OFFICE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. No elected official may change his or her political party affiliation during the official's term of office. 6 7 A "change in political party affiliation" occurs when: (a) Any elected official publicly declares that he or 8 9 she is leaving the political party with which he or she was affiliated when he or she was elected to office; 10 11 (b) Any elected official publicly declares that he or she is becoming a member of a political party which is different 12 13 from the political party with which he or she was affiliated at the time of election. 14 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 15 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor, 16 17 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the United States 18 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the 19 20 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and 21 extended. SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2.2

22 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 23 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 24 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
