- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8
- 9 SECTION 1. Section 47-5-572, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 47-5-572. (1) A privately operated correctional facility 11
- shall not procure goods, to be used by inmates housed in 12
- 13 Mississippi facilities, that have been manufactured using inmates
- in a correctional system of another state if Mississippi Prison 14
- 15 Industries is presently manufacturing the same goods using
- 16 Mississippi inmates, unless the cost of the goods and services can
- be procured at a price that is at least thirty percent (30%) less 17
- than the cost of the same goods and services provided by 18
- 19 Mississippi Prison Industries Corporation.
- 20 (2) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- <u>2</u>009. 21
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 22
- and after July 1, 2007. 23
