HOUSE BILL NO. 583

AN ACT TO CREATE THE "SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT FUND FOR THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING CONTROL ACT"; TO PROVIDE THAT ONE-HALF OF THE FINES, PENALTIES OR OTHER ASSESSMENTS IMPOSED BY THE LAW, OR BY 3 THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING COMMISSION OR ITS EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING CONTROL ACT SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE SPECIAL FUND; TO SPECIFY THAT MONIES 6 7 IN THE FUND SHALL BE EXPENDED BY THE COMMISSION TO PAY THE COSTS OF ENFORCING THE PROVISIONS OF THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING CONTROL ACT; TO AMEND SECTION 75-76-129, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, IN 8 9 CONFORMITY THERETO; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

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- **SECTION 1.** (1) Of all fines, penalties or other assessments 12
- 13 imposed by law, or by the Mississippi Gaming Commission or the
- 14 executive director of the commission, for violations of the
- provisions of this chapter, one-half (1/2) shall be deposited into 15
- 16 the special fund created in subsection (2) of this section. The
- 17 other one-half (1/2) of such fines, penalties or assessments and
- any funds that are derived from taxes, fees, interest, damages or 18
- 19 other monies collected under the provisions of this chapter shall
- 20 be deposited as provided in Section 75-76-129.
- 21 There is created in the State Treasury a special fund,
- to be designated as the "Special Enforcement Fund for the 2.2
- Mississippi Gaming Control Act," to the credit of the Mississippi 23
- 24 Gaming Commission. The special fund shall be comprised of the
- monies required to be deposited into the fund under this section,
- and any other funds that may be made available for the fund by the 26
- 27 Legislature. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer
- as a special fund, separate and apart from the General Fund of the 28
- 29 state.

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- (3) Monies in the fund shall be expended by the Mississippi 30
- 31 Gaming Commission, upon appropriation by the Legislature, to pay * HR03/ R973* H. B. No. 583 G1/2 07/HR03/R973

- 32 the costs of enforcing the provisions of the Mississippi Gaming
- 33 Control Act, Section 75-76-1 et seq. Unexpended amounts remaining
- 34 in the special fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse
- 35 into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment
- 36 earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit
- 37 of the special fund.
- 38 **SECTION 2.** Section 75-76-129, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 39 amended as follows:
- 40 [Through June 30, 2022, this section shall read as follows:]
- 41 75-76-129. On or before the last day of each month all
- 42 taxes, fees, interest, penalties, damages, fines or other monies
- 43 collected by the State Tax Commission during that month under the
- 44 provisions of this chapter, with the exception of (a) the local
- 45 government fees imposed under Section 75-76-195, * * * (b) an
- 46 amount equal to Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000.00) of the
- 47 revenue collected pursuant to the fee imposed under Section
- 48 75-76-177(1)(c), and (c) the amount of one-half (1/2) of any
- 49 fines, penalties and assessments imposed by law, or by the
- 50 Mississippi Gaming Commission or the executive director of the
- 51 commission, for violations of the provisions of this chapter,
- 52 shall be paid by the State Tax Commission to the State Treasurer
- 53 to be deposited in the State General Fund. The local government
- 54 fees shall be distributed by the State Tax Commission pursuant to
- 55 Section 75-76-197. An amount equal to Three Million Dollars
- 56 (\$3,000,000.00) of the revenue collected during that month
- 57 pursuant to the fee imposed under Section 75-76-177(1)(c) shall be
- 58 deposited by the State Tax Commission into the bond sinking fund
- 59 created in Section 65-39-3. The amount of one-half (1/2) of the
- 60 fines, penalties and assessments imposed by law, or by the
- 61 Mississippi Gaming Commission or the executive director of the
- 62 commission, and collected during that month shall be deposited
- 63 into the special fund created in Section 1 of this act.

[From and after July 1, 2022, this section shall read as

65 **follows:**]

- 66 75-76-129. On or before the last day of each month, all
- 67 taxes, fees, interest, penalties, damages, fines or other monies
- 68 collected by the State Tax Commission during that month under the
- 69 provisions of this chapter, with the exception of the local
- 70 government fees imposed under Section 75-76-195 and with the
- 71 exception of one-half (1/2) of any fines, penalties and
- 72 assessments imposed by law, or by the Mississippi Gaming
- 73 Commission or the executive director of the commission, for
- 74 violations of the provisions of this chapter, shall be paid by the
- 75 State Tax Commission to the State Treasurer to be deposited in the
- 76 State General Fund. The local government fees shall be
- 77 distributed by the State Tax Commission pursuant to Section
- 78 75-76-197. The amount of one-half (1/2) of the fines, penalties
- 79 and assessments imposed by law, or by the Mississippi Gaming
- 80 Commission or the executive director of the commission, and
- 81 collected during that month shall be deposited into the special
- 82 <u>fund created in Section 1 of this act.</u>
- 83 **SECTION 3.** Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a
- 84 separate code section in Chapter 76, Title 75, Mississippi Code of
- 85 1972.
- 86 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 87 and after July 1, 2007.
