- AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW SECTION OF LAW TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 49-7-33.1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT THE PLACING OF GRAIN UNDER OR IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO LIGHTING DEVICES 2 3
- 4 FOR THE PURPOSE OF HUNTING; TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION
- 5 THEREOF; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 7
- 8 49-7-33.1, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 9 49-7-33.1. (1) It is unlawful to place grain under or in
- close proximity to any lighting device or light amplifying device 10
- for the purpose of hunting, trapping, taking or killing of any 11
- 12 wild bird or wild animal of any kind.
- (2) For purposes of this section, it is not required that an 13
- 14 individual be engaged in the act of hunting to be in violation,
- the act of placing grain under or in close proximity to such 15
- lighting device during any open season of any wild bird or wild 16
- animal of any kind shall establish a prima facie case of 17
- 18 violation.
- (3) Any person who is found to be in violation of this 19
- section, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a Class II violation 20
- 21 and shall be punished as provided in Section 49-7-143.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2.2
- and after July 1, 2007. 23
