HOUSE BILL NO. 617

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 33-7-405, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO PROVIDE AUTHORITY OF THE ADJUTANT GENERAL TO AUTHORIZE STATE 3 EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FUNDS FOR ROOM AND BOARD PAYMENTS 4 TO QUALIFIED INDIVIDUALS IN AN OFFICER PRODUCING PROGRAM; AND FOR 5 RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 33-7-405, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

33-7-405. The Adjutant General is hereby authorized to pay 9 the tuition, room and board for any active member of the 10 Mississippi National Guard who is enrolled or may enroll within 11 12 the State of Mississippi in an accredited institution of higher learning, vocational education school or junior college. To be 13 14 eligible for such benefits, the individual, at the time of his initial enrollment, must be a captain, lieutenant, warrant 15 officer, cadet, officer candidate or enlisted member of the 16 Mississippi National Guard, or a member of such guard who is 17 18 participating in the educational program authorized by this 19 section as of the effective date of this article; be at least seventeen (17) years of age; and be a resident and a qualified 20 21 elector of the State of Mississippi. To be eligible for the room 22 and board grant, an individual must also be in an officer producing program and be selected to receive the grant by the 23 Adjutant General. The tuition may only be used for undergraduate 24 studies and vocational education courses, whether such coursework 25 is taken on a semester or clock-hour basis. In no event will any 26 individual be eligible for payment of tuition after receipt of an 27 28 undergraduate degree, whether received through this article or

not. No person shall be eligible for a tuition <u>and/or a room and</u> <u>board</u> grant for more than ten (10) years after the date of the first tuition payment for him under this article. The Adjutant General shall set up minimum standards for performance that must be met in order to maintain eligibility for continuing in the program.

35 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 36 and after July 1, 2007.
