HOUSE BILL NO. 623

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-33, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY CERTAIN PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE HUNTING OR KILLING OF 2 3 DEER WITH THE AID OF BAIT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 49-7-33. (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings 8 9 of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of calls of any kind, except a person: 10 11 (a) May use electrically amplified sound devices for hunting coyote and crow; 12 May use liquid scents for any animal or bird; and 13 (b) May use lures for trapping furbearing animals, 14 (C) 15 beaver, coyote, fox and nutria according to regulations adopted by the commission; and 16 (d) May hunt deer with the aid of bait if the bait is 17 not within the hunter's immediate line of sight. Unless a person 18 is openly and visibly hunting deer with the aid of bait within his 19 immediate line of sight, law enforcement officers of the 20 21 department may not issue a citation or fine any person. The commission, in its discretion, may relax the 2.2 (2)restrictions regarding the use of lures or sound devices if a 23 condition arises or exists, as decided by the State Board of 24 25 Health or county board of health, that may endanger persons or 26 livestock in a certain community, county or area.
