## HOUSE BILL NO. 633

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-19-71, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE EXPUNCTION OF A CRIMINAL RECORD; AND FOR RELATED 2 3 PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 4 SECTION 1. Section 99-19-71, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 99-19-71. (1) Any person who has been convicted of a 8 misdemeanor or a felony, other than a violation under Chapter 3 or 5 of Title 97, which offense was committed before the person 9 reached his twenty-first birthday, and excluding a conviction for 10 11 a traffic violation, and who is a first offender, may petition the justice, county, circuit or municipal court, as may be 12 13 applicable, for an order to expunge any such conviction from all public records. Upon entering such order, a nonpublic record 14 15 thereof shall be retained by the court and by the Mississippi Criminal Information Center solely for the purpose of determining 16 whether, in subsequent proceedings, such person is a first 17 18 offender. The effect of such order shall be to restore such person, in the contemplation of the law, to the status he occupied 19 20 before such arrest. No person as to whom such order has been entered shall be held thereafter under any provision of law to be 21 guilty of perjury or to have otherwise given a false statement by 22 reason of his failure to recite or acknowledge such arrest or 23 conviction in response to any inquiry made of him for any purpose, 24 except for the purpose of determining in any subsequent 25 proceedings under this section, whether such person is a first 26 27 offender.
