## HOUSE BILL NO. 685

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 39-11-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXTEND THE REPEALER ON THE AUTHORITY OF THE MISSISSIPPI ARTS COMMISSION TO USE CERTAIN BOND PROCEEDS DEPOSITED INTO THE BUILDING FUND FOR THE ARTS FOR COSTS INCURRED BY THE COMMISSION IN PROVIDING ASSISTANCE RELATED TO CERTAIN PROJECTS TO JULY 1, 2009; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 39-11-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

10 39-11-13. (1) (a) A special fund, to be designated as the "Building Fund for the Arts," is created within the State 11 12 Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from the General 13 Fund of the state. The fund shall consist of any money designated 14 for deposit therein from any source, including, but not limited 15 to, any state general obligation bonds issued for the purposes 16 17 described in this section. Unexpended amounts remaining in the 18 fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall 19 be deposited into such fund. 20

(b) Money deposited into the fund shall be disbursed, in the discretion of the Mississippi Arts Commission, to provide grants to nonprofit organizations that are qualified as tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and units of local government to pay the costs of:

(i) Repair, upgrading, expansion, renovation or
enhancement of existing buildings and facilities for the
presentation, teaching or exhibition of the arts in any and all of

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29 its forms and furniture, equipment and/or technology for such 30 buildings or facilities;

(ii) Construction of new buildings and facilities for the presentation, teaching or exhibition of the arts in any and all of its forms and furniture, equipment and/or technology for such buildings or facilities; or

(iii) The development, construction, equipping and
furnishing of an entertainment and film center and museum and
completion of a sound stage project.

38 (c) The entity to which such grants are made shall
39 provide matching funds from local, federal or private sources
40 equal to forty percent (40%) of the proposed project cost in order
41 to be eligible for a grant under this section.

42 (d) The maximum aggregate amount of monies in the special fund that may be used to provide grant funds to an entity 43 44 or combination of entities under paragraph (b)(iii) of this 45 subsection shall not exceed One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), and no monies in the special fund may be used to provide grant 46 47 funds under paragraph (b)(iii) of this subsection after July 1, 2003. The maximum aggregate amount of grant funds that may be 48 49 provided to an entity or combination of entities under paragraph 50 (b)(iii) of this subsection during a fiscal year shall not exceed 51 Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00).

(2) (a) Amounts deposited into such special fund shall be 52 53 disbursed to pay the costs of projects described in subsection (1) of this section. If any monies in the special fund are derived 54 55 from proceeds of bonds issued under Sections 3 through 18 of Chapter 541, Laws of 2001, as amended by Chapter 540, Laws of 56 2002, as amended by Chapter 519, Laws of 2003, as amended by 57 58 Chapter 1, Laws of 2004 Third Extraordinary Session, as amended by House Bill No. 1634, 2006 Regular Session, and are not used within 59 60 four (4) years after the date such bond proceeds are deposited into the special fund, then the Mississippi Arts Commission shall 61 \* HR03/ R561\* H. Monies in the special fund which are derived from 64 (b) 65 proceeds of bonds issued after April 9, 2002, may be used to 66 reimburse reasonable actual and necessary costs incurred by the 67 Mississippi Arts Commission in providing assistance directly 68 related to a project described in subsection (1) of this section 69 for which grant funds are provided under this section from the use of proceeds of such bonds. Reimbursement may be made only until 70 71 such time as the project is completed. An accounting of actual 72 costs incurred for which reimbursement is sought shall be maintained for each project by the Mississippi Arts Commission. 73 74 Reimbursement of reasonable actual and necessary costs for a project shall not exceed three percent (3%) of the proceeds of 75 bonds issued for such project. Monies authorized for a particular 76 77 project may not be used to reimburse administrative costs for 78 unrelated projects. This paragraph (b) shall be repealed from and 79 after July 1, 2009.

80 The Mississippi Arts Commission is expressly authorized (3) and empowered to receive and expend any local or other source 81 82 funds in connection with the expenditure of funds provided for in 83 this section. The expenditure of money deposited into the special 84 fund shall be under the direction of the Mississippi Arts Commission, and such funds shall be paid by the State Treasurer 85 86 upon warrants issued by the Department of Finance and Administration upon request of the Mississippi Arts Commission, 87 88 which warrants shall be issued upon requisitions signed by the Executive Director of the Mississippi Arts Commission, or his or 89 90 her designee.

91 (4) The Mississippi Arts Commission shall adopt necessary 92 rules and regulations to govern the administration of the program 93 described in subsection (1) of this section, including, but not 94 limited to, rules and regulations governing applications for

The Mississippi Arts Commission shall comply with 97 the provisions of the Mississippi Administrative Procedures Law. 98 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 99 and after July 1, 2007.
