HOUSE BILL NO. 687

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-39, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 WHICH PROVIDES THE MUNICIPAL CRIME PREVENTION FUND; TO EXTEND THE 2 3 DATE OF REPEAL ON THIS SECTION FROM JUNE 30, 2007, TO JUNE 30, 4 2009; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 45-1-39, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6
- amended as follows: 7
- 8 45-1-39. (1) There is created within the State Treasury a
- 9 special fund to be known as the Municipal Crime Prevention Fund.
- The Department of Public Safety shall distribute monies out of the 10
- 11 fund to each municipality in this state on a per capita basis,
- using the population figures from the most recent federal 12
- decennial census; however, no municipality shall receive less than 13
- Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) from the fund. Funds received 14
- 15 by municipalities under this section may be expended for, without
- 16 limitation, any of the following purposes:
- 17 (a) Law enforcement;
- (b) Equipment, technology, supplies, contractual 18
- services, including training and related travel, and commodities; 19
- 20 State or federal crime prevention grant matching
- 21 requirements; and
- 22 (d) Any crime prevention programs implemented by more
- than one (1) jurisdiction, which may include the State of 23
- 24 Mississippi and any of its agencies, departments or political
- subdivisions, through the use of interlocal cooperation 25
- 26 agreements.
- (2) This section shall stand repealed on June 30, 2009. 27

28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
