- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** No candidate may seek election for two (2) or
- 6 more offices simultaneously. This section shall apply to any
- 7 general, special, primary or runoff election that is held in the
- 8 state.
- 9 **SECTION 2.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 10 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 11 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 12 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 13 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 14 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 15 extended.
- 16 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 18 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
