- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Mississippi Department of Transportation
- 7 shall conduct a study of the feasibility of constructing a bypass
- 8 on and along U.S. Highway 72 around the City of Corinth,
- 9 Mississippi. The study shall include a detailed analysis and
- 10 report of:
- 11 (a) The existing and projected traffic count along the
- 12 proposed route;
- 13 (b) The costs for the construction and improvement of
- 14 such bypass;
- 15 (c) The economic impact that the construction of such
- 16 bypass may have upon business, industry and tourism located within
- 17 the City of Corinth and the surrounding area; and
- 18 (d) Such other information and data as the department
- 19 determines relevant to the study.
- 20 (2) The department shall file a report of its findings and
- 21 recommendations with the Secretary of the Senate, the Clerk of the
- 22 House of Representatives and the chairmen of the Senate Highways
- 23 and Transportation Committee and the House Transportation
- 24 Committee on or before January 8, 2008.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2007.
