7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Upon vouchers submitted by the board of
9	supervisors of any county housing persons in the county jail who
10	are incarcerated on the basis of action taken by the Department of
11	Human Services, the department shall pay to the county, out of any
12	available funds, the maximum daily rate paid to counties under
13	Section 47-5-901 for housing state inmates in county jails. The
14	department shall make the payment to the county for each day that
15	the person is confined in the county jail beginning with the fifth
16	day following the date that the person is incarcerated and
17	terminating on the date that the person is released or otherwise
18	removed from the custody of the county jail. In addition, the
19	department shall pay to the county the actual cost of providing
20	medical care to those persons unless the Executive Director of
21	Human Services finds that the costs are unreasonable. The funds
22	received by the county under this section shall be placed in the
23	county general fund and shall be expended only for the housing of
24	those persons in the county jail.
25	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
