1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-7-335, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO SPECIFY THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH LOCAL SCHOOL BOARDS SHALL GRANT FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVERS FROM THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN FEES CHARGED BY THE SCHOOL BOARDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Section 37-7-335, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	37-7-335. (1) The school board of any school district shall
9	be authorized to charge reasonable fees, but not more than the
10	actual cost, for the following:
11	(a) Supplemental instructional materials and supplies,
12	excluding textbooks;
13	(b) Any other fees designated by the local school board
14	as fees related to a valid curriculum educational objective,
15	including transportation; and
16	(c) Extracurricular activities and any other
17	educational activities of the school district $\underline{\text{that}}$ are not
18	designated by the local school board as valid curriculum
19	educational objectives, such as band trips and athletic events.
20	(2) (a) All fees authorized to be charged under this
21	section, except those fees authorized under subsection (1)(c) of
22	this section, shall be charged only upon the condition that the
23	school board of each school district shall adopt a financial
24	hardship waiver policy that shall be kept in the strictest of
25	confidence with all files and personal disclosures restricted from
26	review by the general public. The financial hardship waiver

policy must be distributed in writing to pupils at the time of

enrollment. Any family who qualifies for the National School

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- 29 Lunch Program, as created by the Richard B. Russell National
- 30 School Lunch Act (42 USCS Section 1751 et seq.), shall receive a
- 31 financial hardship waiver.
- The board shall insure that a pupil eligible to have any such
- 33 fees waived as a result of an inability to pay for those fees,
- 34 shall not be discriminated against nor shall there be any overt
- 35 identification of any pupil who has received a financial hardship
- 36 waiver by use of special tokens or tickets, announcements, posting
- 37 or publication of names, physical separation, choice of materials
- 38 or by any other means. In no case shall any school district's
- 39 procedures expose any pupil receiving a hardship waiver to any
- 40 type of stigma or ridicule by other pupils or school district
- 41 personnel.
- 42 (b) The confidentiality of the financial hardship
- 43 waiver policy adopted by the school board shall apply to any
- 44 students who have an inability to pay any fees authorized under
- 45 subsection (1) * * * of this section.
- 46 (3) In no case shall the inability to pay the assessment of
- 47 fees authorized under the provisions of this section result in a
- 48 pupil being denied or deprived of any academic awards or
- 49 standards, any class selection, grade, diploma, transcript or the
- 50 right to participate in any activity related to educational
- 51 enhancement.
- 52 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 53 and after July 1, 2007.
