- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 97-17-42, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 97-17-42. (1) Any person who shall, willfully and without
- 8 authority, take possession of or take away a motor vehicle
- 9 belonging to another, and any person who knowingly shall aid and
- 10 abet in such taking possession or taking away, shall be guilty of
- 11 a felony and shall be punished by commitment to the Department of
- 12 Corrections for not more than ten (10) years.
- 13 (2) Any person convicted under Section 97-17-42 who causes
- 14 damage to any motor vehicle shall be ordered by the court to pay
- 15 full restitution to the owner or owners of any such motor vehicle
- 16 or to any other person in lawful possession thereof at the time of
- 17 the taking. No person ordered to pay such restitution shall be
- 18 released or discharged from probation or post-release supervision
- 19 until restitution has been paid in full.
- 20 (3) This section shall not apply to the enforcement of a
- 21 security interest in a motor vehicle.
- 22 (4) Any person who shall be convicted for a second or
- 23 subsequent offense of taking and carrying away, feloniously, a
- 24 motor vehicle which is the personal property of another, of any
- 25 value, shall be guilty of grand larceny, and shall be imprisoned
- 26 in the Penitentiary for a term not exceeding <u>fift</u>een (15) years or

- 27 shall be fined not more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars
- 28 (\$15,000.00), or both.
- 29 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
