- 10 **SECTION 1.** Section 19-5-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 19-5-15. (1) The boards of supervisors of the several 12 13 counties of this state, in their discretion, may use the road equipment of the counties and county employees to dig graves for 14 the burying of dead livestock if the graves are upon the premises 15 of the owner of the livestock or upon property provided by the 16 17 owner.
- 18 (2) The authority granted under subsection (1) of this section shall not be applicable to commercial livestock 19 20 operations.
