- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-9-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 37-9-13. Each school district shall have a superintendent of
- 9 schools, selected in the manner provided by law. No person shall
- 10 be eligible to the office of superintendent of schools unless such
- 11 person shall hold a valid administrator's license issued by the
- 12 State Department of Education and shall have had not less than
- 13 three (3) years of * * * administrative experience.
- 14 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 15 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,
- 16 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 17 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 18 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 19 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 20 extended.
- 21 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 23 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
