6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
7	SECTION 1. Section 37-9-49, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:
9	37-9-49. * * * The school district superintendent may deduct
10	or permit to be deducted from the salary of any superintendent,
11	principal, teacher or other employee * * * dues * * * payable
12	because of the membership of such superintendent, principal,
13	teacher or other employee in a professional organization or
14	association. However, the dues deduction may be made only upon
15	written authorization from the superintendent, principal, teacher
16	or other employee requesting the deduction. School boards may
17	adopt policies and procedures for implementing this voluntary dues
18	deduction process. Dues or premiums in health associations or
19	corporations and tax sheltered annuity deductions authorized by
20	the United States Internal Revenue Code may be deducted upon
21	written authorization from the superintendent, principal, teacher
22	or other employee involved. Any superintendent of schools who
23	shall make any <u>unauthorized</u> deduction or permit any <u>unauthorized</u>
24	deduction to be made * * * shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and
25	upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than
26	Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each such deduction.
27	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
