HOUSE BILL NO. 1004

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-33-155, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE COMPOSITION OF THE STATE BOARD OF REHABILITATION 2 3 SERVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 37-33-155, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 37-33-155. (1) There is created the State Board of Rehabilitation Services, which shall be reconstituted as follows 8 on July 1, 2007: The board shall consist of seven (7) members, 9 five (5) members to be appointed by the Governor and two (2) 10 11 members to be appointed by the Lieutenant Governor * * *. Of the * * * members appointed by the Governor, one (1) shall 12 be a person who is visually impaired, one (1) shall be a person 13 who is hearing impaired or hard of hearing, one (1) shall be a 14 person who is physically impaired, one (1) shall be a person who 15 is mentally impaired or the parent of a person who is mentally 16 impaired, and one (1) shall be a person who uses assistive 17 18 technology. Of the members appointed by the Governor, four (4) shall be from separate congressional districts and one (1) shall 19 be from the state at large, with one (1) appointed for a term to 20 expire on July 1, 2008, one (1) appointed for a term to expire on 21 July 1, 2009, one (1) appointed for a term to expire on July 1, 22 2010, one (1) appointed for a term to expire on July 1, 2011, and 23 one (1) appointed for a term to expire on July 1, 2012. The 24 25 members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor shall be from the state at large, with one (1) appointed for a term to expire on 26 27 July 1, 2008, and one (1) appointed for a term to expire on July

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1, 2009. Upon the expiration of the initial terms, the members 28 29 shall be appointed for terms of five (5) years from the expiration date of the previous term. All original and later appointments 30 shall be with the advice and consent of the Senate. 31 An 32 appointment to fill a vacancy, other than by expiration of a term 33 of office, shall be made for the balance of the unexpired term. 34 No board appointee shall be an employee or elected official of the State of Mississippi or a political subdivision thereof, * * * or 35 an employee of the Division of Rehabilitation Services of the 36 37 Department of Human Services or any subordinate administrative unit of the division before July 1, 1991, or an employee of the 38 39 State Department of Rehabilitation Services after June 30, 1991.

The board shall elect a chairperson from its membership 40 (2)at the first meeting of the original board members and every two 41 (2) years thereafter on July 15 of the year. A majority of the 42 43 membership of the board shall constitute a quorum for the 44 transaction of any business, and the board shall meet at least 45 quarterly and hold other meetings as are necessary for the purpose of conducting required business. All meetings of the board shall 46 47 be called by the chairperson, except the first meeting of the original board members, which shall be called by the Governor 48 49 within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this act. 50 The * * * members of the board shall be compensated at a (3) per diem rate as authorized by Section 25-3-69, plus actual and 51 52 necessary expenses as authorized by Section 25-3-41. * * *

53 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 54 and after July 1, 2007.
