- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 SECTION 1. (1) The Mississippi Department of Public Safety,

- 11 Administration, is authorized to relocate the existing offices of
- 12 the Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol, the Mississippi Crime
- 13 Laboratory, and the Public Safety Planning Division, currently
