HOUSE BILL NO. 1054

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE PLANTING OF A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF
2 ACORN-BEARING OR BERRY-BEARING TREES FOR EVERY ONE ACRE OF PINE
3 SEEDLINGS PLANTED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSE.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** For the purpose of providing food necessary for
6 the welfare of wild animals, the owner or owners of forest lands
7 shall be required to plant five (5) acorn-bearing or berry-bearing
8 trees for every one (1) acre of pine seedlings planted.

9 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
10 and after July 1, 2007.
