COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1076

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO EXEMPT MILITARY PERSONNEL WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF MISSISSIPPI AND WHO ARE ON LEAVE FROM AN ACTIVE TOUR OF DUTY FIGHTING THE GLOBAL WAR ON TERROR FROM LICENSURE REQUIREMENTS TO HUNT OR FISH; TO REQUIRE SUCH PERSON TO HAVE ON HIS PERSON WHILE HUNTING OR FISHING PROOF OF AGE AND RESIDENCY AND A COPY OF HIS FORM 31; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 9 **SECTION 1.** Section 49-7-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 10 amended as follows:
- 11 49-7-5. (1) (a) Any resident, as defined in Section
- 12 49-7-3, upon application, shall receive a combination resident
- 13 hunting and fishing license for the sum of Seventeen Dollars
- 14 (\$17.00). Such license shall qualify the licensee to hunt under
- 15 this chapter all game and fowl, including deer and turkey, and to
- 16 fish in any county of the state.
- 17 (b) Any resident, as defined in Section 49-7-3, upon
- 18 application, shall receive a resident combination small game
- 19 hunting and fishing license for the sum of Thirteen Dollars
- 20 (\$13.00) together with the fee provided in Section 49-7-17 to the
- 21 office or agent issuing such license. Such hunting license shall
- 22 qualify the licensee to hunt and fish under this chapter all game
- 23 and fowl, except deer and turkey, in any county in the state.
- 24 (c) Any resident of the State of Mississippi, as
- 25 defined in Section 49-7-3, upon application, shall receive a
- 26 resident small game license, and for it shall pay the issuing
- 27 officer or agent the sum of Thirteen Dollars (\$13.00), together
- 28 with the fee provided in Section 49-7-17 to the officer or agent
- 29 issuing such license. Such hunting license shall qualify the

- 30 person holding the same to hunt under the provisions of this
- 31 chapter, and in season, all game and fowl, except deer and turkey,
- 32 in any county in the state.
- 33 (d) Any resident, as defined in Section 49-7-3, upon
- 34 application, shall receive a sportsman's license for the sum of
- 35 Thirty-two Dollars (\$32.00). Such license shall qualify the
- 36 licensee to hunt under this chapter all game and fowl, including
- 37 deer and turkey, and to fish as provided by law, in any county in
- 38 the state, and to hunt using primitive weapons and bow and arrow
- 39 in the manner provided by law. The commission may notify the
- 40 licensee of the expiration of his license, and the licensee may
- 41 renew the license by mailing the sum of Thirty-two Dollars
- 42 (\$32.00) to the commission. A licensee who has not renewed the
- 43 license within thirty (30) days after the expiration date shall be
- 44 removed from the commission's records, and the licensee must apply
- 45 to be placed on the renewal list.
- 46 (e) In addition to a hunting license allowing the
- 47 taking of turkey, a resident who hunts turkey during a fall turkey
- 48 season must purchase a fall turkey hunting permit for a fee of
- 49 Five Dollars (\$5.00) plus the fee provided in Section 49-7-17. A
- 50 resident sportsman's licensee or resident lifetime sportsman
- 51 licensee may hunt during the fall turkey season without purchasing
- 52 a permit.
- (f) The commission may offer a resident apprentice
- 54 hunting license for a resident who does not have the required
- 55 certificate of hunter education and may set the fee for the
- 56 apprentice hunting license. An apprentice license may be
- 57 purchased only one (1) time by a resident and the apprentice
- 58 hunting licensee must be accompanied by a licensed or exempt
- 59 resident hunter at least twenty-one (21) years of age when
- 60 hunting.
- 61 (2) (a) Any resident citizen of the State of Mississippi
- % who has not reached the age of sixteen (16) years or who has H. B. No. 1076 * HR07/R1691CS*

63 reached the age of sixty-five (65) years, or any resident citizen 64 who is blind, paraplegic, or a multiple amputee, or who has been 65 adjudged by the Veterans Administration as having a total service-connected disability, or has been adjudged to be totally 66 67 disabled by the Social Security Administration, or any resident citizen who is an active member of the United States Armed Forces 68 69 on leave from an active tour of duty fighting the global war on 70 terror shall not be required to purchase or have in his 71 possession, a hunting or fishing license while engaged in such 72 activities. A person exempt by reason of total service-connected 73 disability, as adjudged by the Veterans Administration or who has 74 been adjudged to be totally disabled by the Social Security 75 Administration or who is blind, paraplegic or a multiple amputee, 76 shall have in their possession and on their person proof of their 77 age, residency, disability status or other respective physical 78 impairment while engaged in the activities of hunting or fishing. 79 A person exempt by reason of being an active member of the United 80 States Armed Forces on leave from an active tour of duty fighting the global war on terror shall have in their possession and on 81 their person while hunting or fishing proof of their personal 82 identification, age, residency and a copy of their Form 31. The 83 84 provisions of this paragraph shall stand repealed on July 1, 2008. 85 All exempt hunting and fishing licenses previously issued for disabilities shall be null and void effective July 1, 86 87 1993. The commission may offer a youth all-game hunting 88 (C) 89 and fishing license for exempt youths who have a hunter education certificate and an all-game hunting and fishing license for other 90 91 persons exempted under paragraph (a). Youths and other exempt persons shall not be required to purchase this license or have it 92 93 in possession while hunting or fishing. The commission may 94 establish a fee not to exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00) for such 95 licenses.

- 96 (3) No license shall be required of residents to hunt, fish
- 97 or trap on lands in which the record title is vested in such
- 98 person.
- 99 (4) Any person or persons exempt under this section from
- 100 procuring a license shall be subject to and must comply with all
- 101 other terms and provisions of this chapter.
- 102 (5) Any person authorized to issue any license under this
- 103 section may collect and retain for the issuance of each license
- 104 the additional fee authorized under Section 49-7-17.
- 105 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 106 and after July 1, 2007.
