## HOUSE BILL NO. 1097

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-227, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCREASE THE COMPENSATION OF POLL WORKER MANAGERS AND CLERKS;
- 3 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-227, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 23-15-227. The managers and clerks shall be each entitled to
- 8 Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per day for each election; provided,
- 9 however, that the board of supervisors may, in its discretion, pay
- 10 the managers and clerks an additional amount not to exceed
- 11 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per election. The manager or other
- 12 person who shall carry to the place of voting, away from the
- 13 courthouse, the official ballots, ballot boxes, pollbooks and
- 14 other necessities, shall be allowed Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for
- 15 each voting precinct for so doing. The manager or other person
- 16 who acts as returning officer shall be allowed Fifteen Dollars
- 17 (\$15.00) for each voting precinct for that service. The
- 18 compensation authorized in this section shall be allowed by the
- 19 board of supervisors, and shall be payable out of the county
- 20 treasury.
- 21 The compensation provided in this section shall constitute
- 22 payment in full for the services rendered by the persons named for
- 23 any election, whether there be one (1) election or issue voted
- 24 upon, or more than one (1) election or issue voted upon at the
- 25 same time.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi
- 27 shall submit this act, immediately upon approval by the Governor,

- 28 or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a veto, to the
- 29 Attorney General of the United States or to the United States
- 30 District Court for the District of Columbia in accordance with the
- 31 provisions of the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended and
- 32 extended.
- 33 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 34 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting
- 35 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
