COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1105

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 2145, LAWS OF 2006, TO EXTEND THE 1 EXISTENCE OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF A 2 3 STATE CIVIL RIGHTS MUSEUM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Chapter 2145, Laws of 2006, is amended as 5 follows: 6 7 WHEREAS, the Legislature finds that there is a need to closely examine and further study the feasibility of establishing 8 9 a civil rights museum in the City of Jackson, Mississippi: NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF 10 11 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN, That: 12 There is hereby created a study committee for the purpose of 13 studying the feasibility of establishing a civil rights museum in 14 the City of Jackson, Mississippi. The study committee shall be 15 composed of the following: 16 (a) The Executive Director of the State Department of 17 Archives and History, or his designee; 18 (b) Three (3) members of the Senate to be appointed by 19 20 the Lieutenant Governor; (c) Three (3) members of the House of Representatives 21 to be appointed by the Speaker of the House; and 22 Members of the committee who are not legislators shall not 23 receive any compensation or per diem, but may receive travel 24 reimbursement provided under Section 25-3-41. Legislative members 25 of the committee shall receive per diem, travel or other expenses, 26 27 if authorized by the Management Committees of the Senate and the * HR40/ R1025CS*

House of Representatives, from the contingent expense funds of 28 their respective houses in the same amounts as provided for 29 committee meetings when the Legislature is not in session; provide 30 31 that no per diem or expense for attending meetings of the 32 committee shall be paid while the Legislature is in session. The study committee shall be dissolved on July 1, 2008. 33 34 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. 35
