1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-111-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO SPECIFY THE VARIOUS AGENCIES AND OFFICIALS FROM WHICH THE CHILD DEATH REVIEW PANEL MAY OBTAIN THE INFORMATION NECESSARY FOR THE REVIEW PANEL TO CARRY OUT ITS DUTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
б	SECTION 1. Section 41-111-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	41-111-1. (1) There is created the Child Death Review
9	Panel, whose primary purpose is to foster the reduction of infant
10	and child mortality and morbidity in Mississippi and to improve
11	the health status of infants and children.
12	(2) The Child Death Review Panel shall be composed of
13	fifteen (15) voting members: the State Medical Examiner or his
14	representative, a pathologist on staff at the University of
15	Mississippi Medical Center, an appointee of the Lieutenant
16	Governor, an appointee of the Speaker of the House of
17	Representatives, and one (1) representative from each of the
18	following: the State Coroners Association, the Mississippi
19	Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the Office of Vital
20	Statistics in the State Department of Health, the Attorney
21	General's Office, the State Sheriff's Association, the Mississippi
22	Police Chiefs Association, the Department of Human Services, the
23	Children's Advocacy Center, the State Chapter of the March of
24	Dimes, the State SIDS Alliance, and Compassionate Friends.
25	(3) The Chairman of the Child Death Review Panel shall be
26	elected annually by the Review Panel membership. The Review Panel

shall develop and implement such procedures and policies necessary

for its operation, including obtaining and protecting confidential

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- 29 records from the agencies and officials specified in subsection
- 30 (4) of this section. The Review Panel shall be assigned to the
- 31 State Medical Examiner's Office for administrative purposes only,
- 32 and the Medical Examiner shall designate staff to assist the
- 33 Review Panel.
- 34 (4) The Child Death Review Panel shall submit a report
- 35 annually to the Chairmen of the House Public Health and Human
- 36 Services Committee and the Senate Public Health and Welfare
- 37 Committee on or before December 1. The report shall include the
- 38 numbers, causes and relevant demographic information on child and
- 39 infant deaths in Mississippi, and appropriate recommendations to
- 40 the Legislature on how to most effectively direct state resources
- 41 to decrease infant and child deaths in Mississippi. Data for the
- 42 Review Panel's review and reporting shall be provided to the
- 43 Review Panel, upon the request of the Review Panel, by the State
- 44 Medical Examiner's Office, State Department of Health, Department
- of Human Services, medical examiners, coroners, health care
- 46 providers, law enforcement agencies, any other agencies or
- 47 officials having information that is necessary for the Review
- 48 Panel to carry out its duties under this section. The State
- 49 <u>Medical Examiner's</u> Office shall also be responsible for printing
- 50 and distributing the annual report(s) on child and infant deaths
- 51 in Mississippi.
- 52 (5) This section shall stand repealed on July 1, 2010.
- 53 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 54 and after July 1, 2007.
