HOUSE BILL NO. 1151

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-23-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO DEFINE INCORPORATED COMPANY FOR THE CRIME OF EMBEZZLEMENT; AND 3 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 97-23-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 97-23-19. (1) Any director, agent, clerk, servant, or officer of any incorporated company, or if any trustee or factor, 8 9 carrier or bailee, or any clerk, agent or servant of any private person, shall embezzle or fraudulently secrete, conceal, or 10 11 convert to his own use, or make way with, or secrete with intent to embezzle or convert to his own use, any goods, rights in 12 13 action, money, or other valuable security, effects, or property of any kind or description which shall have come or been entrusted to 14 15 his care or possession by virtue of his office, place, or employment, either in mass or otherwise, with a value of Five 16 Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or more, he shall be guilty of felony 17 embezzlement, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned in 18 the Penitentiary not more than ten (10) years, or fined not more 19 20 than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or both. If the value of 21 such goods, rights in action, money or other valuable security, effects, or property of any kind is less than Five Hundred Dollars 22 (\$500.00), he shall be guilty of misdemeanor embezzlement, and, 23 upon conviction thereof, shall be imprisoned in the county jail 24 25 not more than six (6) months, or fined not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or both. 26

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27 (2) For the purposes of this section "incorporated company"
 28 includes all lawful entities created under Title 79.

29 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 30 and after July 1, 2007.
