## HOUSE BILL NO. 1159

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-15-303, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REVISE THE COMPOSITION OF THE STATE AND SCHOOL EMPLOYEES HEALTH 2 3 INSURANCE MANAGEMENT BOARD TO INCLUDE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF 4 THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 25-15-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 8 25-15-303. (1) There is created the State and School 9 Employees Health Insurance Management Board, which shall 10 administer the State and School Employees Life and Health 11 12 Insurance Plan provided for under Section 25-15-3 et seq. The State and School Employees Health Insurance Management Board, 13 14 hereafter referred to as the "board," shall also be responsible for administering all procedures for selecting third-party 15 administrators provided for in Section 25-15-301. 16 (2) The board shall consist of the following: 17 18 (a) The Chairman of the Workers' Compensation 19 Commission; The State Personnel Director; 20 (b) The Commissioner of Insurance; 21 (C) The Commissioner of Higher Education; 2.2 (d) The State Superintendent of Education; 23 (e) (f) The Executive Director of the Department of Finance 24 25 and Administration; 26 The Executive Director of the State Board for (g) Community and Junior Colleges; 27

(h) Two (2) appointees of the Governor whose terms 28 29 shall be concurrent with that of the Governor, one (1) of whom 30 shall have experience in providing actuarial advice to companies that provide health insurance to large groups and one (1) of whom 31 32 shall have experience in the day-to-day management and 33 administration of a large self-funded health insurance group; 34 (i) The Chairman of the Senate Insurance Committee, or his designee; 35 The Chairman of the House of Representatives 36 (j) 37 Insurance Committee, or his designee; (k) The Chairman of the Senate Appropriations 38 39 Committee, or his designee; and 40 The Chairman of the House of Representatives (1) 41 Appropriations Committee, or his designee. The legislators, or their designees, shall serve as ex 42 43 officio, nonvoting members of the board. 44 The Executive Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall be the chairman of the board. 45 46 The board shall meet at least monthly and maintain (3)47 minutes of such meetings. A quorum shall consist of a majority of the authorized voting membership of the board. The board shall 48 49 have the sole authority to promulgate rules and regulations 50 governing the operations of the insurance plans and shall be vested with all legal authority necessary and proper to perform 51 52 this function including, but not limited to: 53 (a) Defining the scope and coverages provided by the 54 insurance plan; 55 Seeking proposals for services or insurance through (b) 56 competitive processes where required by law and selecting service 57 providers or insurers under procedures provided for by law; and (c) Developing and adopting strategic plans and budgets 58 59 for the insurance plan.

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60 The department shall employ a State Insurance Administrator, 61 who shall be responsible for the day-to-day management and 62 administration of the insurance plan. The board shall employ a Deputy State Insurance Administrator who shall be an actuary and a 63 64 member of the American Academy of Actuaries. The Deputy State 65 Insurance Administrator shall have experience in providing 66 actuarial services to companies which provide health insurance to 67 large groups. The deputy administrator shall receive a salary set by the board and shall not be subject to the authority of the 68 69 State Personnel Board for any purpose. The Department of Finance 70 and Administration shall provide to the board on a full-time basis 71 personnel and technical support necessary and sufficient to 72 effectively and efficiently carry out the requirements of this 73 section.

74 (4) Members of the board shall not receive any compensation 75 or per diem, but may receive travel reimbursement provided for 76 under Section 25-3-41 except that the legislators shall receive per diem and expenses which shall be paid from the contingent 77 78 expense funds of their respective houses in the same amounts as 79 provided for committee meetings when the Legislature is not in 80 session; however, no per diem and expenses for attending meetings 81 of the board shall be paid while the Legislature is in session. 82 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 83 and after July 1, 2007.
