HOUSE BILL NO. 1161 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF STATE 1 2 INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING, BY AND THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION, TO CONVEY CERTAIN STATE-OWNED REAL 3 PROPERTY LOCATED IN WASHINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MISSISSIPPI DELTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE; TO REQUIRE THE 4 5 BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MISSISSIPPI DELTA COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO CARRY 6 OUT CERTAIN FUNCTIONS RELATIVE TO THE MANAGEMENT AND OPERATION OF 7 8 THE GREENVILLE HIGHER EDUCATION CENTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 10 **SECTION 1.** (1) The State of Mississippi, acting through the Department of Finance and Administration and on behalf of the 11 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, is 12 13 authorized to convey to the Board of Trustees of Mississippi Delta Community College, for the use and benefit of the Greenville 14 15 Higher Education Center, the following real property in Washington 16 County, Mississippi: 40.00 acres, more or less, located in Sections 13 and 17 18 14, Township 17 North, Range 8 West, Washington County, 19 Mississippi, and being more particularly described as 20 follows: Commence at a 3/4" iron pipe in concrete on the corner 21 common to Sections 13, 14, 21, and 22, Township 17 22 23 North, Range 8 West, Washington County, Mississippi; thence North 00 degrees 00 minutes 06 seconds West along 24 the line common to said Sections 13 and 14, 1,320.04 25 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence continue North 00 degrees 26 00 minutes 06 seconds West along said common line 27 between Sections 13 and 14 - 2035.67 feet to the Point 28 of Beginning of the parcel herein described; thence 29 30 North 85 degrees 39 minutes 30 seconds West 564.05 feet * HR03/ R1603PH* H. B. No. 1161 G1/2 07/HR03/R1603PH

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to a 4/8" iron rod set on the east right-of-way line of 31 32 U.S. Highway No. 1; thence along the east right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 1, North 04 degrees 20 minutes 33 34 30 seconds East 896.27 feet to a concrete right-of-way 35 marker; thence continue along said right-of-way line, North 04 degrees 20 minutes 30 seconds East 103.73 feet 36 to a point on the south right-of-way (40 feet from the 37 centerline) of Archer Range Road; thence along the south 38 right-of-way line of Archer Range Road, North 80 degrees 39 40 58 minutes 54 seconds East 1,081.32 feet; thence continue along said south right-of-way line of Archer 41 Range Road, North 82 degrees 53 minutes 40 seconds East 42 464.37 feet; thence South 837.90 feet to the north 43 right-of-way line of an ANR Pipeline Company easement; 44 thence along said north right-of-way line of the ANR 45 Pipeline easement, South 39 degrees 15 minutes 23 46 47 seconds West 517.71 feet; thence North 85 degrees 39 minutes 30 seconds West 653.02 feet to the Point of 48 49 Beginning, together with all improvements situated 50 thereon and all appurtenances thereunto belonging, LESS AND EXCEPT all easements and rights-of-way of record. 51 52 SECTION 2. (1) The Board of Trustees of Mississippi Delta 53 Community College shall be responsible for the management and 54 upkeep of the above-described property, as well as any facilities 55 thereon and any improvements that may at some future date be 56 constructed on the site. The board of trustees shall enter into 57 any contracts necessary with Delta State University, Mississippi 58 Valley State University, or any other agency or governing

59 authority of state or local government or any private entity, to 60 ensure that appropriate fees are paid to the Greenville Higher 61 Education Center for the use of the facility.

62 (2) The Board of Trustees of Mississippi Delta Community
63 College shall ensure that the Greenville Higher Education Center
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carries out the purposes assigned in Section 18, Chapter 538, Laws 64 of 1997. The Department of Finance and Administration and the 65 institutions of higher learning are authorized to convey the above 66 67 described property on the condition that it shall be used for the purposes provided for in this act, and further provided that the 68 property shall revert to the state in the event that the Board of 69 Trustees of Mississippi Delta Community College fails to operate 70 the center as provided for in this act. 71 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 72

73 and after July 1, 2007.
