HOUSE BILL NO. 1238

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE OWNER OF AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TO 1 REGISTER SUCH VEHICLE WITH THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT OF THE COUNTY 2 OF HIS OR HER RESIDENCE; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 3 4 SAFETY TO ESTABLISH A STATEWIDE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE REGISTRATION NETWORK DESIGNED TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE RESPONSE TO SHERIFFS' 5 б DEPARTMENTS AND LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES WITH REGARD TO REPORTS OR 7 COMPLAINTS OF STOLEN OR MISSING ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES; TO PROVIDE 8 FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSITION OF FEES FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE NETWORK; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC 9 SAFETY TO DEVELOP AND OFFER AN ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SAFETY COURSE 10 11 CONDUCTED BY AND USING COURSE MATERIALS, CURRICULA AND INSTRUCTORS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE COURSE SHALL BE 12 AVAILABLE FREE OF CHARGE TO ANY PERSON WHO WISHES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COURSE WHO HAS REGISTERED HIS ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE AS 13 14 15 PROVIDED UNDER THIS ACT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 17 SECTION 1. (1) The term "all-terrain vehicle" or "ATV," as used in this section, means any motorized vehicle manufactured and 18 19 designed exclusively for off-road use that is fifty (50) inches or less in width, has an unladen dry weight of seven hundred fifty 20 21 (750) pounds or less, travels on three (3), four (4) or more low pressure tires, has a seat designed to be straddled by the 22 23 operator and uses handlebars for steering control.

24 (2) Beginning July 1, 2007, every owner of an all-terrain vehicle who is a resident of this state, shall register such 25 vehicle with the sheriff of the county in which the owner resides. 26 Registration shall be made in duplicate on a form prepared and 27 provided to the sheriff by the Mississippi Department of Public 28 Safety. Each form shall include (a) the name and address of the 29 owner of the vehicle; (b) the age and sex of the owner; (c) the 30 31 make, model and serial number of the vehicle; (d) the name and address of the person, firm or business from whom such vehicle was 32

33 acquired or purchased and the date of acquisition or purchase; and 34 (e) the place where such vehicle is usually kept.

35 (3) The original registration form shall be retained by the sheriff in a safe and convenient file to be furnished him by the 36 37 board of supervisors for that purpose and also may be recorded on 38 computer or other electronic format. All registrations shall be 39 filed and arranged and/or formatted for retrieval in alphabetical 40 order and shall be open to public inspection as required under the Mississippi Public Records Act of 1983. 41 A copy of the 42 registration form shall be forwarded to the Department of Public Safety within thirty (30) days after completion of registration. 43 44 The department shall file and maintain copies of all registrations filed with it and shall establish and maintain a statewide ATV 45 46 registration network designed to provide immediate response to sheriffs' departments and other law enforcement agencies with 47 48 regard to reports or complaints of stolen or missing ATVs. At the 49 time of registration, the sheriff shall issue to the registrant a 50 decal for placement on the ATV. The decal shall be designed by the Department of Public Safety and shall be provided to the 51 52 sheriff by the department. Each decal shall contain such numbers 53 and/or other vehicle identifying information as the Department of 54 Public Safety may prescribe.

55 (4) At the time of registration, the registrant shall pay to the sheriff a one-time fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00). 56 Six Dollars 57 (\$6.00) of the fee shall be forwarded to the Department of Public Safety at the time that the sheriff's department is required under 58 59 subsection (3) of this section to provide the department with a copy of the registration. Four Dollars (\$4.00) of the fee shall 60 be retained by the sheriff and shall be paid to the chancery clerk 61 for deposit into the general fund of the county. The fees 62 received by the Department of Public Safety shall be deposited 63 64 into the Department of Public Safety Administrative Fund created 65 under Section 45-1-21 and may be expended by the department, upon * HR12/ R1690*

(5) The Department of Public Safety shall develop and offer 68 69 an all-terrain vehicle safety course conducted by and using course 70 materials, curricula and instructors provided by the department. 71 The course shall be available free of charge to any person who wishes to participate in the course who has registered his 72 all-terrain vehicle as provided under this section. 73 The department shall issue a certificate to each person who 74 75 satisfactorily completes such course.

76 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 77 and after July 1, 2007.
